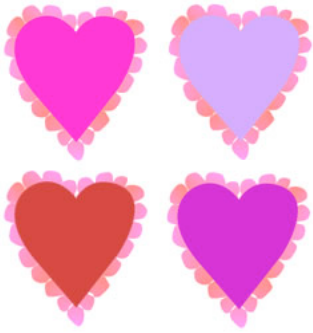

SMART Notebook 10 Idea!

1. Place a folder on your desktop: Right-click > New > Folder > (type in a name for this folder..."SMART").
2. Save your lessons, templates, etc. into this folder for handy, quick retrieval.
3. Also, you can create folders within the "SMART" folder for organization (Math, LArts, Science...).
