# FACTS Grant & Aid ACCEPTING FINANCIAL AID APPLICATIONS FOR 2023/2024 beginning 12/1/2022. APPLY EARLY!!



These sources of financial aid are available to families of students at Star of the Sea Catholic School.

- o The McMahon Parater Foundation -- Available to eligible Catholic and non-Catholic students.
- o The Parish Sharing Awards -- Available to eligible Catholic families registered and active in a local Diocesan parish.
- o EISTC Tax Credit Scholarship -- Available to eligible Catholic and non-Catholic families.

#### <u>Families must apply and meet FACTS Grant and Aid criteria for need to be</u> <u>considered for any of the financial aid sources listed above.</u>

Please note that the deadline to apply for Round 1 financial aid is March 1, 2023. **Your FACTS Grant & Aid Application and ALL supporting documents must be submitted by March 1, 2023**, to be considered in Round 1 awards. If you apply after the March 1st deadline, and qualify for aid, you will be considered for aid in Round 2 (6/1 deadline) or round 3 awards if funds are still available.

FACTS representatives are available to assist you if you have any questions regarding the online application process (866-441-4637). Please be sure to upload all your documents as requested. Look for emails from FACTS Grant & Aid as they will notify you of any missing information.

#### Additional Criteria for Star of the Sea School Financial Aid:

- Account Status: All account balances must be current (i.e., tuition, technology fees, cafeteria, before/aftercare, etc.)
- You must apply for financial aid each school year to be considered for an award.
- Financial aid awards ARE NEVER carried over from year to year.

# Counselors Corner 19 Gerald Ott



Last Counselors Corner covered Test Anxiety. That form of anxiety is a specific phenomenon related to tests and is far from the only source of anxiety students experience in school. Some types of Anxiety students may experience in school can be as follows: Separation anxiety is When children are worried about being apart from their parents or caregivers. This can be a pervasive problem at drop-off and throughout the day. Social anxiety is When children are excessively self-conscious constantly believing that they need to be different or are not good enough. This makes it difficult for them to participate and socialize with peers. Selective mutism is When children have a tough time speaking in some settings. This can make it hard to participate and get answers to the questions the student may have. Generalized anxiety is when children worry about an enormous range of things. Kids with generalized anxiety lend themselves often to perfectionism and can be self-punitive. Obsessive-compulsive disorder is much broader than just a type of anxiety. But it can be characterized as When children's minds are filled with unwanted and stressful thoughts, in which Kids with OCD try to alleviate their anxiety by performing compulsive rituals. Commonly children can have specific phobias in which they fear particular things outside of the norm which may interfere with their school life.

Anxiety is often treated based on the specific needs of the students and is sometimes helpful to seek therapy or a medical opinion. Although some general things make Anxiety better. Having healthy eating, physical activity, recommended amount of sleep, mindfulness, or relaxation, are all ways to stay healthy and Generally can reduce the symptoms of Anxiety. Most importantly students who struggle with anxiety are Often helped most through their support system and their parents. Having people in their lives who support them and help quell those anxious thoughts are the best help.


